## Expected Standard of Behaviour in the Library

Westland District Library is a Council facility provided for all residents and visitors to use and enjoy, so it is important to show respect and consideration to others using the library.

## What do we expect from you?

- Respond to all reasonable requests from library staff
- Respect the rights of others. Unlawful, noisy, offensive and threatening behaviour is not tolerated in or around the library
- Leave the library and its contents as you found them, so others can enjoy them
- Watch your possessions at all times the library is a public place and is not responsible for any theft that may occur
- Leave animals outside, except if they are needed to assist a person with a disability
- Avoid injury to others and leave bicycles, scooters, skateboards etc. outside, clear of the entrance and preferably in the bike stand
- All large backpacks and strollers to be left in the foyer area
- Keep the entrance and exit, aisles, doorways and fire exit routes clear at all times

## What happens if expectations are not met?

- Unacceptable behaviour by a library user may result in the withdrawal of library privileges
- You may be asked to leave the library
- If an individual's behaviour is threatening or frightening to other library users or library staff, the Police will be contacted to provide assistance.
