The Application

This is an application by **Trinity Foods Limited** for the variation of the OFF Licence in respect of premises situated at 24 Main Road, Franz Josef Glacier known as "**Four Square Franz Josef.**"

The business is that of a large grocery with aisles and carry baskets. It stocks a full range of food products and other household goods.

The current days & hours are **Monday to Sunday 7.00am to 11.00pm.**
applicant seeks to amend those to 7.00am to 10.00pm.

They also want to formally amend the Single Alcohol Area (SAA) to that as depicted in the new plan dated 16 October 2023.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The application is complete and contained all the necessary information and notifications as required under s.120 of the Act and its regulations. It was duly advertised, and no public objections were received.

We are satisfied that the exposure of alcohol to shoppers will continue to be limited as far as is reasonably practicable and the variation is approved.

Similarly the reduced hours sought are approved.

The reports from the Police and the Medical Officer of Health carry no matters in opposition.

Overall, we are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.120 of the Act.

Accordingly, we deal with the matter on the papers.

DECISION

The District Licensing Committee Chairman, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **approves** an application by **Trinity Foods Limited** for the **variation of the OFF Licence in respect of premises situated at 24 Main Road, Franz Josef Glacier known as “Four Square Franz Josef”** subject to conditions.

Conditions:


The licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold on, or delivered from, the premises for consumption off the premises, and supplied free as a sample for consumption on the premises, only on the following days and hours:
Monday to Sunday 7:00AM to 10:00PM;
2. No alcohol is to be sold on or delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday or Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day
3. While alcohol is being supplied free as a sample, water is to be provided to patrons free of charge at the place where the samples are being supplied
4. No alcohol may be sold other than alcohol that contains no more than 15% ethanol by volume measured at 20°C and is –
 - a. beer that complies with the applicable New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - b. mead that complies with the applicable New Zealand food standard for mead; or

- c. fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the applicable New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
 - d. grape wine that complies with the applicable New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
 - e. a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted.
5. A properly appointed Certificated, or Acting or Temporary, Manager must be on duty, at or nearby the point of sale, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
- a. At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the inside of the premises so as to be easily read by people entering each principal entrance to the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
7. The “single alcohol area” for the premises is as described on the plan dated **16/10/2023**. The licensee must ensure that:
- a. No alcohol is displayed, promoted or advertised outside the single alcohol area; and;
 - b. No products other than alcohol, low-alcohol and non-alcoholic beer, wine or mead are displayed, promoted or advertised inside the single alcohol area.

The licence expiry is unchanged and will expire on 1 June 2024.
