Official information request for a list of all building in the Westland District that have been determined dangerous

I refer to your official information request dated 25 March 2025 for a list of all buildings with the Council's jurisdiction that have been determined dangerous, affected or insanitary (as defined under Section 121-123 of the Building Act 2004).

You have asked for the following information:

- 1. All buildings that have been determined to be dangerous, affected, or insanitary from January 1, 2020 to present;
- 2. All buildings determined to be dangerous, affected, or insanitary prior to January 1, 2020 that still have active notices, unresolved issues, or ongoing council oversight.

I can confirm there are no buildings within Westland District Council's jurisdiction that have been determined to be dangerous, affected or insanitary as defined under Sections 121-123 of the Building Act 2004.

There will be no charge in supplying this information to you.
