## Official information request for urban water pricing

I refer to your official information request dated 12 September 2022 for urban water pricing.

Enclosed is information we can release without any charge.

Please note that:

- Our larger southern Water Treatment facilities are specifically geared to provide peak tourism water supply levels required pre-Covid. That number exceeded 600,000 visitors, so production/usage figures are excessive for population.
- Westland Milk Productions is a very large commercial user in Hokitika. Due to their consumption and in conjunction with tourism numbers previously noted, the production versus static residential population will appear highly distorted.
- Over the last 4 years we have undertaken major upgrades at all our water plants, this will continue over the next 2 years. These improvements will allow WDC to provide more accurate and details data with ease.
