**THE APPLICATION**

This is an application by **Emiliano Hernandez Ciucci** for a manager's certificate to manage licensed premises known as the **Te Waonui Forest Retreat**.

**REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The applicant holds the prescribed Licence Controller Qualification/s and is employed in licensed premises.

The Licensing Inspector has provided a report outlining the applicant's experience in controlling licensed premises and has tested their understanding of their responsibilities as a manager.

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concern about the overall suitability of the applicant, nor do they oppose the granting of the application.

**However, the Police do rightly note that he cannot perform the role of Duty manager until his Work Visa is amended to permit such activity.**

Subject to the above, the application can be dealt with on the papers.

## **DECISION**

The application and supporting information satisfy the committee that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.222 of the Act have been met.

The District Licensing Committee Chairman, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** an application by **Emiliano Hernandez Ciucci** for a Manager's Certificate.

The applicant is to make contact with Immigration NZ and seek an amendment to his Work Visa before he can be appointed as a Duty Manager.

The certificate is valid for twelve months from the date the certificate is issued.
