#### Hi Steven

That wasn't the intention at all and I'm sorry you think that way.

I haven't bought into the agenda of anyone and am disappointed that you have thrown that at me. The role of a deputy mayor is to work closely with the mayor, to take the lead on some of the issues and conseins that arise, to work with the wider community groups as well as stand in for the mayor in the mayors' absence.

The fact you put a lot of time into reading reports pre meetings is commendable but has no relevance to the role of deputy mayor – it's what everyone is expected to do.

The fulfilment of your role as my deputy

I need a deputy that

communicates with me, that works with me, that is out there meeting with community groups and that I can share an element of the workload with. By being active out in the wider community and with the many community groups, workload content becomes part of that. I don't see these requirements as being over the top and if fulfilled, would sit in alignment with the remuneration that sits with the position. I must be able to war lify input versus remuneration in that position as I do with my own.

We obviously have a difference in interpretation of the Deputy's role and how it works. I would have liked to have had the opportunity to work with you on improving the difference that is not opportunity to work with you on improving the difference that is not what you want.

Thanks, Helen, It's vivious that you are wanting to create the impression that I resigned because I didn't want to continue in this role rate than include the full resaoning. Also, the idea that releasing it would cause disharmony amongst the team doesn't make sense to me. There is disharmony because it was clear that you had bought into the agenda from a group of

other councillors who questioned my contribution and worth in the deputy mayor role. I believe explaining why I had to resign would actually improve the tone within the council and hopefully stop this petty stuff once and for all. I did not want to resign but had no choice as you created an environment where my role would all be about the hours I engag. I with community groups and how often I sat in the desk at council with no recognition given to the actual real work had been doing so far. I am far more prepared and engage more actively at council meetings because I spend a lot of time preparing for the real issues that are important. The issue of my hours and performance plus my commitment to the role to justify the \$60k remuneration I found very offensive. This seems to have come to a head as a result of my absence during he b/Mar. This was a period of absence that I discussed with you well in advance soon after the election and got your agreement to do so. I feel that I have been let down and not supported by you during that period and you allowed yourself to be bought into inaccurate rhetoric and speculation during that period as to my commitment to the role even though I allowed a full day to zoom to the Feb council meeting plus also attended the council zoom briefing on the 27/2.

I have put in my resignation letter the reasons why I have resigned and you have accepted that the facts are there is a reason I took this decision and you are trying to change the narrative as to why I felt I had to resign. I stand my decision and the reasons why and expect that to be understood and communicated. The people who voted for me also need an explanation as to the decision I have made.

I'd also note that at the end of the museum workshop on the 22/3, you communicated to all councillors that you had an expectation that they should all attend the online briefing from Takiwa Poutini I note that at that meeting, I was the only representative from WDC – there were 3 from Buller and 2 from Grey. My commitment to my role at council is without question in my view.

I am travelling to Hokitika and won't be back until this evening where I ntend to be present at the Heritage Hokitika meeting.



## Dear Helen

I am tendering my resignation as deputy mayor as I no longer have the confidence and support from you to continue in this role.

During the election campaign, it was clear that we shared a lot of common concerns about the big issues that the council would be facing mostly as a result of what the previous council and mayor have created but also the new challenges that needed to be addressed. When you asked me to be your deputy, I saw this as a great proortunity to work together to quickly start working through these issues. 
