This is an application by **Stevenson Supermarket Limited** for a Temporary Authority for premises situated at 140 Stafford Street, Hokitika known as "**Stafford Street Four Square**"

An OFF Licence, 56/OFF/020/2026, is operative at the premises and expires on the **25th of February 2029**.

The application contains supporting documentary evidence showing a sale and purchase agreement and there are reports from the Police and the Inspector that do not raise any matters in opposition.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concerns about the suitability of the applicant, nor do they oppose the granting of the order.

Accordingly, the application will be dealt with by the Committee on the papers.

DECISION

The application and supporting information satisfy us that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.136 of the Act, has been met.

The District Licensing Committee, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 makes an order for a Temporary Authority for **3 months** to **Stevenson Supermarket Limited** from **4th of May 2026**.

The conditions relating to OFF LICENCE 56/OFF/020/2026 shall continue to apply.
