I refer to your official information request dated 03 July 2023 for Transfer Station information for the Westland District.

You have asked for the following information:

1. How many Waste Transfer Stations are there within your area? (Please list)

8 – Hokitika, Kumara, Ross, Hari Hari, Whataroa, Franz Josef, Fox Glacier and Haast.

2. What materials are they permitted to handle?

Kumara, Ross and Hari Hari – general waste, recycling and uncompacted green waste, gas bottle disposal, whiteware and tyres.

Whataroa, Franz Josef, Fox Glacier and Haast Landfill – general waste, recycling and uncompacted green waste, gas bottle disposal, whiteware and tyres.

Hokitika – E-Waste, oil, batteries, general waste, recycling and uncompacted green waste, gas bottle disposal, whiteware and tyres.

3. How far are they away from any residential zoned sections?

Kumara – N/A Rural and Small Settlement Zone.

Ross – N/A Rural and Small Settlement Zone.

Hokitika – 200m from Residential Mixed Zone.

Hari Hari – N/A Rural and Small Settlement Zone.

Whataroa – N/A Rural and Small Settlement Zone.

Franz Josef – 80m from Residential Zone.

Fox Glacier – 367m from Residential Zone.

Haast – N/A Rural Zone.

4. Which was established first – Nearest Residential sections or Waste Station?

Residential sections existed prior to both waste facilities. Although, formal residential zoning was not introduced until 2002.
