I refer to your official information request dated 29 April 2025 for information on mobility parking spaces.

You have asked for the following information:

- 1. The total number of designated mobility (disability) parking spaces managed by your council on public land.**

There are 23 disability mobility parking spaces throughout the Westland District that are under Council control.
