Official information request for policy information on council workshops and briefings

I refer to your official information request dated 11 October 2024 for policy information on council workshops and briefings.

1. What is your council's current policy in relation to whether elected member workshops and briefings are open to the public?

Workshops are open to the public unless the provisions of Section 48 of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 apply.

2. Did your council open up, or is it in the process of opening up, these workshops and briefings to be "open to the public by default: in line with the Ombudsman's recommendations in his "Open for Business" report of October 2023?

This is the general process that is followed.

3. If you have opened up, or are intending to open up, these workshops and briefings to the public, how are you doing so? (e.g. internet livestreaming, public attendance in person, after the fact video or audio recordings etc.).

Workshops open to the public are live-streamed to the Council's YouTube channel, a link is available on the Council Website, a public notice is placed in the local newspaper, the public are invited to attend, agendas and minutes of the workshops are available on the Council Website.

Workshops that are publicly excluded are advertised as such in the local newspaper, and on the Council Website.
